Scholarship Program Guidelines

The CCIM Foundation's CCIM Endowed Scholarship Program was created to support qualified real estate professionals in their efforts to achieve the CCIM designation. Recipient should exemplify the high caliber of professionals that comprise the CCIM Institute.

Scholarship Selection Criteria

Includes the following:

- Each applicant should be able to demonstrate a commitment to a commercial real estate career (see application).
- Each applicant should be able to demonstrate active involvement as a dues paying member with a local CCIM Chapter (see application).

Scholarship Value

Recipient will receive a **scholarship in the amount of \$1,000** to be used toward tuition in **one** of the following CCIM designation courses: **CI 101, CI 102, CI 103 or CI 104.**

NOTE: Scholarship recipient will be responsible for reimbursing the Foundation for the full cost of a failed course; failing the course renders the scholarship null and void.

Procedure

Applications are submitted directly to the individual's local CCIM Chapter.

NOTE: The award certificate can only be redeemed for a 2021 course. The scholarship cannot be applied retroactively to any course already taken; the award is not redeemable for cash; the CCIM Foundation will not reimburse individuals for any courses already taken.

Email notification will be sent on or before December 15 to scholarship winners. Recipient is responsible for submitting his/her course registration form and full payment to register for the course. Upon successful completion of the course, recipient will be reimbursed the scholarship value of \$1,000.00 from the Institute.
